



MACF contracts with the State of Missouri providing Foster Care Case Management services focused on assisting children who have been victims of child abuse and neglect and their families engaged in the child welfare system. Case Managers work to ensure child safety, achieve permanency, and enhance overall well-being.

Performance Metrics:

- o Monthly visits with the worker and child
- o Monthly visits between the worker and parents
- o Monthly visits between child and parent/siblings
- o Case Planning processes
- o On-going medical care
- o Permanency goal established timely.
- o Psychotropic Medication Use
- o Placement types

Outcomes:

- o Permanency: Children who achieved permanency through reunification, adoption, or guardianship.
- o Re-Entry: Children who re-enter the foster care system after achieving permanency
- o Safety: Children who have a Preponderance of the Evidence (POE) finding while in a foster care setting.
- o Medical Care: Children who receive a comprehensive medical exam within 30 days of entering foster care.

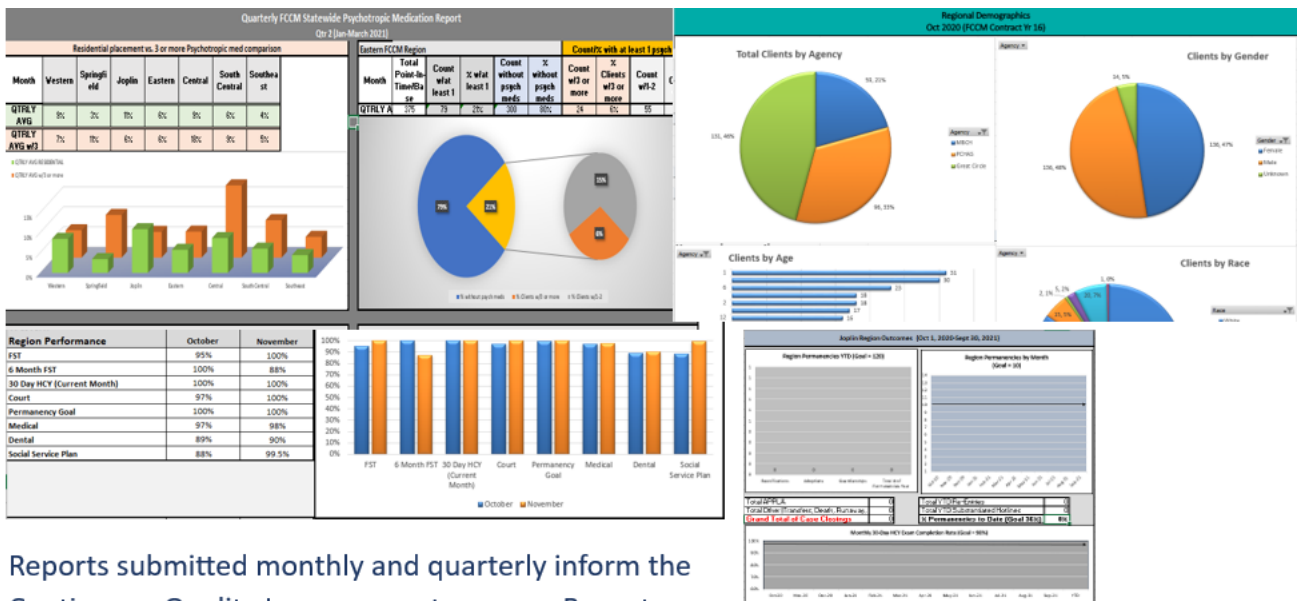
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Data Visualization
