II. Party Game Options

Paper Scissors Rock

- Everyone starts with their camera on.
- Everyone starts by secretly choosing one person to play against. You do not announce who you are playing against.
- The facilitator says “paper, scissors, rock”. On “rock” everyone shows their choice.
- If you lose you turn off your screen.
- If you win or it is a draw, keep screen on and choose a person to play against in the next round.
- Repeat. Game keeps going until there is an ultimate winner.

Never Have I Ever

- Everyone turns off their cameras.
- One person will start with “Never have I ever....” and says a statement that they have never done.
- If that statement applies to you, turn on your camera so you can see who the statement applies to.
- Everyone turns camera off again.
- Depending on how many people are on the call, can have everyone say one.

2 Truths and a Lie

- Say your name, organization, and 2 truths and a lie. Everyone guesses what the lie is.

Zoom Around the Room

- Facilitator/Judge - everyone else races to find objects and return to the video
- 1st person to return with the object- 3 points; 2nd- 2 points; 3rd – 1 point (could do just 1st and 2nd person if 3 is too challenging)
- Person with most points at the end of the game wins
- The group can do as many rounds as you want. Below are ideas for up to 8 rounds (feel free to make up your own):
 - Find something..... purple
 -that does not belong to you
 -that reminds you of your childhood
 -that starts with the 1st letter of your 1st name
 -with a Chicago sports team logo
 -that you can see through
 -that starts with the letter ‘q’
 -that has a hole in it

I Spy

- Looking at everyone's Zoom screens, one "it" person starts with... "I spy with my little eye something..." and ends with something descriptive (e.g., ...is blue, begins with the letter G")
- Other participants take turns asking one question each... "Is it flat, does it have wheels, etc."
- The person who has spied something can only respond with "yes" or no"
- If a participant thinks they know what the mystery item is, they can use their question to guess directly... "Is it... ??"
- Once a person guesses correctly, they become "it" and the game moves on from there.

Create a Group Song

- Choose a song genre or theme.
- In the chat, have everyone add a line or lyric adding to the group song.

White Board Pictionary

- To use Zoom's whiteboard, click on the share screen button and select whiteboard. You will then be able to use your mouse to draw.
- Everyone can play as one big team and guess.
- The drawer has 60 seconds to draw and get everyone to guess.
- As the facilitator, a few ideas of questions to private message the person drawing:
 - Scarf
 - Snow
 - Hot Chocolate
 - Lights
 - Icicle
 - Gift
 - Mittens
 - Bonfire
 - S'mores

Closing Question:
